

# FALL LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM

City Council adopted a leaf pickup program for the residents of Woodburn. The leaf program is necessary for safety reasons and for cost effectiveness to the Community. The City streets are swept on a monthly basis. Sweeping is performed twice a week on the main streets in the Downtown Core Area, between Settlemier Avenue to First Street and between Harrison Street to Oak Street, due to the numerous large trees.

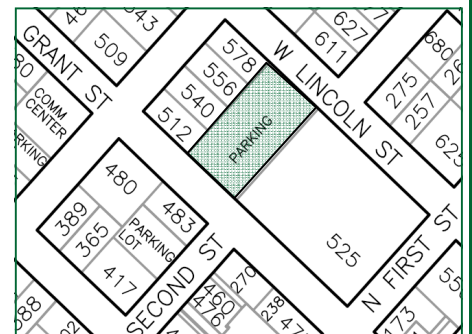
Further, to provide **safety** for our school children, bike paths on Settlemier Avenue to West Hayes Street, sweeping will also be conducted twice weekly. Leaves on the sidewalk and street right of ways are permitted to be raked onto the street without making a pile, although do not include branches and tree limbs because larger items cause deterioration and can damage the vehicles. All other leaves on private properties are not allowed to be placed on the street pavement per **Ordinance No 2225**.

Leaf drop-offs will be for **Residents only** (no Commercial drop-off). The only location designated this year will be at the parking area on Second Street behind the Woodburn Post Office between Lincoln Street and Grant Street (see map below). This area will have staff available, will be gated and rules and regulations will be posted.

With the other locations unavailable, the Maintenance Division will have pick-up days for **Seniors** who are unable to make drop-offs. Scheduling **must** be made in advance. Pick-up times are from 8:00 AM-11:30 AM on Fridays on the following dates: November 13th & 20th and December 11th & 18th. Please, contact our Maintenance Division office at (503)982-5236.

Other options: **Compost in backyard**, use **yard debris cart weekly**, **North Marion Disposal Facility**.
