



Volunteer Position Description

Storytime Assistant

Help young children and their caregivers enjoy stories from the Library's collection of children's books. While storytime is geared toward young children and their caregivers, all are welcome and elementary school children may come during summer and school breaks.

Duties: Set up children's room for storytime. Assist with children's craft activities. Participate in storytime activities under the direction of the Children's Librarian. Activities may include reading aloud, singing songs, and playing games with children

Qualifications: All volunteers must complete a City of Woodburn Volunteer Application, background check (18yrs+), and orientation. Must be patient, energetic, friendly, and enjoy working with young children. Ability to read-aloud to children in an entertaining manner. Spanish language is useful but not required.

Time Commitment: Minimum of 1 hour per week with a seasonal commitment.

- Spanish Storytime: Tuesday @ 4:00pm
- Family Storytime: Wednesday @ 10:30am

Compensation:

Students will gain valuable real life experience working for a government organization that they will be able to use on college and job applications. Hours spent at working for the City of Woodburn may also be used for Senior Projects and/or volunteer hours. Students who perform well may obtain a letter of recommendation or a reference from City staff.
