# Current RSVP Volunteer Opportunities for Woodburn Community.



*You've gained a lifetime of experience, now is the time to put your skills and talents to good use by volunteering through RSVP at any of these Woodburn area sites:*

1. **Northwest Senior & Disabilities:** at the Presbyterian Church at 950 N Boones Ferry Rd, Woodburn. Drivers for Meals-on-Wheels are needed Monday-Friday, assistance also needed in preparing and packing the meals, 9am-12pm.
  2. **AWARE Food Bank:** 152 Arthur St., Woodburn. Opportunities to pack food boxes, organize food shelves, greet clients and more; Monday-Friday from 9am-12pm.
  3. **Dial-A-Ride:** 202 Young St., Woodburn, 503-982-7433. Looking for volunteers with a driver's license to drive Woodburn residents to medical appointments in the Portland & Salem area and all points in-between. Volunteers choose days/hours they are available to drive and can always turn down a request. Volunteers are reimbursed for their mileage at a rate of \$.555 per mile. Program operates Monday-Friday between the hours of 6am-5pm.
  4. **Woodburn Tax-Aide:** At the Public Library, Woodburn. Now through April, training provided. Help prepare taxes on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays anytime between 9:30am-3pm.
  5. **SMART Readers:** Nellie Muir or Lincoln in the Woodburn School District. Be a reader with K-3rd grade students to help improve their reading skills. Program times vary depending on school, volunteers needed 1 to 2 hours a week.
  6. **Planting Communities:** Community gardens at various locations throughout Woodburn. Share your green thumb, or whatever color yours may be, in this wonderful community collaboration to help families eat healthier and become a bit more self-sustaining. Days and times are flexible, but a commitment of 2-4 hours a week in a garden would be amazing!

7. **North Marion Middle School:** 20246 Grim Rd NE, Aurora. Be a Student Enrichment-time Coordinator and tutor students in math, reading, teach a class to a small group of students (i.e. quilting, cooking, gardening, 4-H) or help supervise students in the library, computer lab or gym during intramurals. Every Wednesday from 7:45am-9:45am.
8. **Chemeketa Community College-Woodburn Center:** 120 E Lincoln St., Woodburn, 503-981-8820. A great opportunity for retired teachers or school personnel, providing academic instructional support to individuals studying for their GED tests. Program is Monday-Thursday from 9am-12pm or 5pm-9pm. Amount of hours per shift is flexible.
9. **Aurora Colony Historical Society:** 15018 2nd St., Aurora. Opportunities to staff the museum reception desk, be a museum tour guide, help with cleaning and maintenance needs, be a greeter for a special event, or be a living history guide for school children March-June. Days/hours flexible.
10. **Country Meadows Courtside:** 155 S Evergreen, Woodburn, 971-983-1424. Opportunities to lead exercise class with residents, assist with baking or crafts classes, lead a weekly Bingo game for residents, assist residents in weekly pinochle games and more. Classes/programs operate Tuesday-Friday with classes at 10am and games at 1pm or 1:30pm.

12. **Woodburn Public Library:** 280 Garfield St., Woodburn, 503-982-5259. Assist at the library as an aide pulling holds from paging lists, loading courier bins, shelf reading and more! Flexible volunteer schedule Monday-Saturday.
13. **Woodburn Historical Museum:** 455 N Front St., Woodburn, 503-982-5263. Opportunities to give tours, set-up window displays, light cleaning at museum, or office duties; Saturdays from 11am-3pm.

15. **Chamber of Commerce Visitor's Center:** Outlet Mall, Woodburn, 503-982-8221. Opportunities to speak with visitors, tell them about local attractions and businesses; Monday-Sunday from 11am-2pm, 2pm-5pm, and during the summer a 5pm-8pm shift. Particular need on Sundays.
16. **City of Woodburn Planning Department:** 270 Montgomery St, Woodburn: Volunteers needed to assist with basic office work, filing, and scanning of materials. Days/times are flexible.
17. **Senior Estates Quilters:** Senior Estates Craft Room, Woodburn: Sewers needed to assist with quilt assembly Mondays & Thursdays from 8:30am-2:30pm.
