1:04 COUNCILOR MORRIS' REQUEST TO ATTEND CONFERENCE

Lonergan/Ellsworth... approve Councilor Morris' request to attend the Echelon Front's conference titled "Extreme Ownership" for costs not to exceed \$4,000.Councilor Lonergan stated that he is in favor of this. Councilor Schaub stated that she is in support of training but does have concerns about the violent titles of some of the coursework. Councilor Carney stated that he supports this and looks forward to Councilor Morris bringing this information back to Council. Councilor Morris recused himself from voting. The motion passed unanimously with Councilor Morris not voting.
