Summary: City of Woodburn staff received the e-mailed "paper check" on 3/28/2024 that the County Surveyor's office had sent.

One drawing item remains from the January 9, 2024 transmittal.

The applicant needs to revise drawings per the below:


1. Public easements per land use final decision Attachment 203, Part D, Table 203D:

d. Sheet 2 Detail B: Tract H: The proposed delineated westerly PAE doesn't conform with what Table 203D requires. It doesn't clearly indicate allowance for public utilities (including a bus pad and shelter) and doesn't follow the conditioned geography. Revise the sheet and Sheet 1 plat notes.

After the land use condition, the developer proposed an unanticipated retaining wall. The proposed easement boundary conflicts with the wall location shown on civil plan Sheet L105. The retaining wall displaces the bus pad area farther north, to the corner, so the easement boundary needs to move east to accommodate the rectangular area. Refer back to the civil engineering plan (CEP) review memo of May 3, 2023, pages 3 & 4 illustrations for background, and see also the photos below of the constructed wall.

Then, revise Sheet 2, Detail B so that the easement can fit a concrete pad 12 feet wide by 7 feet deep.
