The word sanitation was chosen instead of disinfect. Hot soap and water can be used, no specific products are required.</li> <li>The user should use the product in accordance with manufacturer instructions (label).</li> <li>Sanitizing is meant to reduce, not kill, the occurrence and growth of bacteria, viruses and fungi. Disinfecting a surface will "kill" the microscopic organisms as claimed on the label of a particular product.</li> </ul>	No link, employer selects products and suppliers.
