Qualifications:

<u>**Time Commitment:**</u> Meetings are twice monthly and are held at the Woodburn Police Department every other Wednesday at 7:30pm. Community service hours will depend on the amount of activities students choose to participate in.

<u>Compensation</u>: Students will gain valuable real life experience volunteering for a government organization that they will be able to use on college and job applications. Hours spent at volunteering for the City of Woodburn may also be used for Senior Projects and/or required volunteer hours. Students who perform well may obtain a letter of recommendation or a reference from City staff member and potentially the mayor.
