Bidders submitting an offer must sign this form, acknowledging receipt of addendum, and supply it with their proposal. Failure to do so will subject the Bidder to disqualification.

### **CLARIFICATIONS BASED ON RECEIVED QUESTIONS:**

- The minor adjustment of manholes shall take place prior to paving operations.

### **REVISIONS TO PART I – BID PREPARATION DOCUMENTS:**

- Delete Page 1 of the Invitation to Bid and replace it with the attached, revised Page 1. Quantities shown on the original Page 1 have been revised.

### **REVISIONS TO PART II – BID FORMS:**

- Delete page BP-3 “Bid Schedule”, from the Form of Proposal, and replace it with the attached, revised Bid Schedule. The revised Bid Schedule reflects updated quantities.

### **REVISIONS TO THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**

**00220.40(e)(1) Lane Closures** – Add the following to the end of this subsection:

Two traffic lanes may be closed when allowed, shown, or directed, but the closure may not span more than a single block. Emergency vehicles shall be accommodated, and coordination with affected residents is required.

Sealed bids for the construction of **“2022-23 Spring Paving Project”** will be received by the City of Woodburn, OR at City Hall Annex, 190 Garfield St. until **2:00 PM, Thursday, February 16, 2023** and will thereafter be publicly opened and read.

Proposals shall be addressed to the Public Works Director, City of Woodburn, and 190 Garfield St., Woodburn, OR 97071. Bids shall be submitted in a plain sealed envelope bearing the Bidder's name, the name of the project and the date and time of the Bid opening, and shall be marked "**Bid No. 2022-08**" and bidders shall indicate on the Form of Proposal that ***“Bidder will comply with the provisions of Chapter 279C.800 through 279C.870, Oregon Revised Statutes”***.

The major items of work are estimated (approximate) quantities as follows:

1. Perform 3-inch “mill and fill” paving operation, 650 tons of asphaltic concrete.
2. Construct 12 new ADA ramps and concrete walks, 1,086 square feet.

Plans and specifications may be examined at the City Engineer's Office, City Hall Woodburn, OR on or after **Monday, January 23, 2023**. Copies of the Bid Documents may be obtained from the City Engineer's Office upon deposit of a non-refundable fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each set. There is no pre-bid conference scheduled. Those not familiar with the Project area can visit the site as depicted on the Project drawings.

Bidders must be pre-qualified in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon. Completed pre-qualification forms or proof of pre-qualification shall conform to the Special Provisions. Only bids from pre-qualified Bidders will be opened.

No bid for a construction contract shall be received or considered unless the bidder is registered with the Construction Contractors Board. The Contractor and every Subcontractor must have a Public Works Bond filed with the CCB before starting work on the project.

Bidders on this project need not be licensed for asbestos handling pursuant to ORS 468A.720. Each bidder must indicate on the bid form whether they are a resident or nonresident bidder as defined in ORS 279A.120 (b).
