# 7. OLD BUSINESS

# Elimination of Overdue Fines on Children's Materials - John Hunter

Hunter revisited earlier discussion describing the library profession's movement away from charging overdue fines for juvenile materials. This is motivated by a desire to eliminate barriers that might inhibit families from borrowing materials for their children. Overdue fines can accrue quickly, especially when families borrow many items, and most get returned eventually. Families would still be charged for lost materials, or those otherwise not returned, so a check on profligacy would remain in place. Fines collected by the library last fiscal year totaled less than \$1,000/month, and youth fines are likely a small portion of the total. The board was generally supportive of moving forward with this narrow proposal. Hunter will return in January with a plan ready for a vote.

# Annual Statistical Report to the State Library - John Hunter

Hunter provided analysis of selected statistics reported annually to the state library. While the library has more registered borrowers, attendance and circulation were lower. Outreach to schools resulted in much greater program attendance. Patrons have access to a very large collection of print and digital material. (See attachment.)

# Children's Playground Proposal - John Hunter

Hunter presented a rudimentary proposal being developed in conjunction with recreation services manager Jesse Cuomo to install a children's playground in Library Square. (See attachment.) Library endowment funds would be used; grant funds would need to be secured as well. The project would cost approximately \$45,000. Hawes expressed concern that the project not intrude such that space for Music in the Park would be adversely affected.


