 - Provided a update on the project. Completing 100% construction documents, including building materials and finishing touches for mechanical and plumbing. Working with the CMGC Triplett Wellman has been very positive and has already helped to avoid potential future change orders.
- b. Settlemier Park Improvement Project
 - Shared that the project has received the following funding sources:
 - A. Legislative funding for Settlemier Park Rehabilitation \$2,000,000
 - B. Local Government Grant (contract pending): \$1,000,000
 - C. Private Donor: \$50,000
 - D. Moda Health and Trail Blazers: \$39,040

- E. Woodburn Rotary: \$25,000

 - Project underway and hopes to be completed by late fall for major completion. Project funded with support of \$700,000 Local Government Grant and Park System Development Charges for match.







Site Plan















5-12 year-old Structure











2-5 year-old Structure
